# ▲ Happy New Year ▲

**Happy New Year** everyone! This New Year we want the club to start out in a new direction. We are going to make a number of New Year's *Resolutions* and we need your help to make them come to fruition.

- 1. We will be more organized.
- 2. We will have more events.
- 3. We will drive our cars more often.
- 4. We will have more opportunities to socialize with club members.

Last year we decided to change the format of our meetings from having a "Pub Night" to having a "Pub Day." (We want to thank Butch and Judy Smith for hosting our first Pub Day last November.) Our "Pub Nights" were held at a local restaurant, on a weeknight at the end of each month. Attending these meetings, we had to fight local traffic gridlock during the evening rush hour to get to the other side of Northern Virginia, put up with slow restaurant service, try to talk to those around you over a loud din of patron noise, were limited to socializing with only those seated around you, and challenged to pay the bill when separate checks were not provided. As a result of popular demand by club members we have now changed the format of our meeting to "Pub Days." Pub Days will occur at a member's house on a weekend day. Attending these meetings, we will incur less traffic, will minimize the impact on the host by ordering simple home delivery food (pizza, Chinese food, subs, etc.) with the attendees sharing the cost, and have more opportunities to socialize with all attendees. We will only schedule a Pub Day for months that there is not another club event or a local car show planned. However, to accomplish this feat we need volunteer club members to host the meetings. We also need club members to cooperate by providing a prompt RSVP so the host can plan for the meeting.

We want to get our cars out of the garage and onto the roads. We need your input on suggestions for interesting drives and volunteers to host the events. We are going to try to schedule events in the future so we can get them on our calendars in advance. Attached is a draft calendar of suggested events for your review and input. We live in a beautiful area for such events and we need to take advantage of the opportunities that are available. We should consider day drives and drives that could be accomplished over a two-day period. In addition to our club events, we have been invited to join MG Car Club of Washington, DC (MGCC) events, which will provide more driving opportunities. #### Directions:

**From the Fairfax County area**, travel to Route 28 South heading towards Manassas. From I-66 this will be about 7 miles. At the intersection of Route 28 (Centreville Road) and Sudley Road, cross Sudley Road. Landmarks will be a Hollywood Video on your right, a CVS Pharmacy across the intersection and a Rite Aid to your left. One block past the CVS Pharmacy, turn right onto Maple Street. Travel one block to stop sign, turn left onto Mathis Avenue. Travel one block to right onto Irving Street. First driveway to the left on Irving Street or street parking is available in front of the house on Mathis Avenue.

**From the Winchester area**, take I-66 East to Route 234 - Exit 44. Travel Route 234 about 4 miles to the exit for Route 28 North. Route 28 is called Nokesville Road on this end of town. Continue Route 28 North - Nokesville Road about 2 miles. You will cross the railroad tracks near Wellington Road and your landmarks as you cross the tracks will be a Sunoco station and a Southern States store on your right. Continue on Route 28 which becomes Center Street past the courthouse and rescue squad complex into Old Town Manassas. Cross the traffic light at Grant Avenue and the next traffic light will be Main Street. Be in the left hand lane and turn left onto Main Street. Landmark is the Olde Towne Inn. Travel one block, cross Church Street and take second right onto Mathis Avenue. Continue one block, turn left onto Irving Street for driveway parking.

For those that would like to visit Historic Old Town Manassas we are a three block walk from the heart of the Historic District. Delisle Antiques, the Art Beat gallery, Dublin of Old Town for the Irish among you, Opera House Gourmet (wines, wines & more wines) and the Whimsical Galerie are among the shops located in the historic district.


